

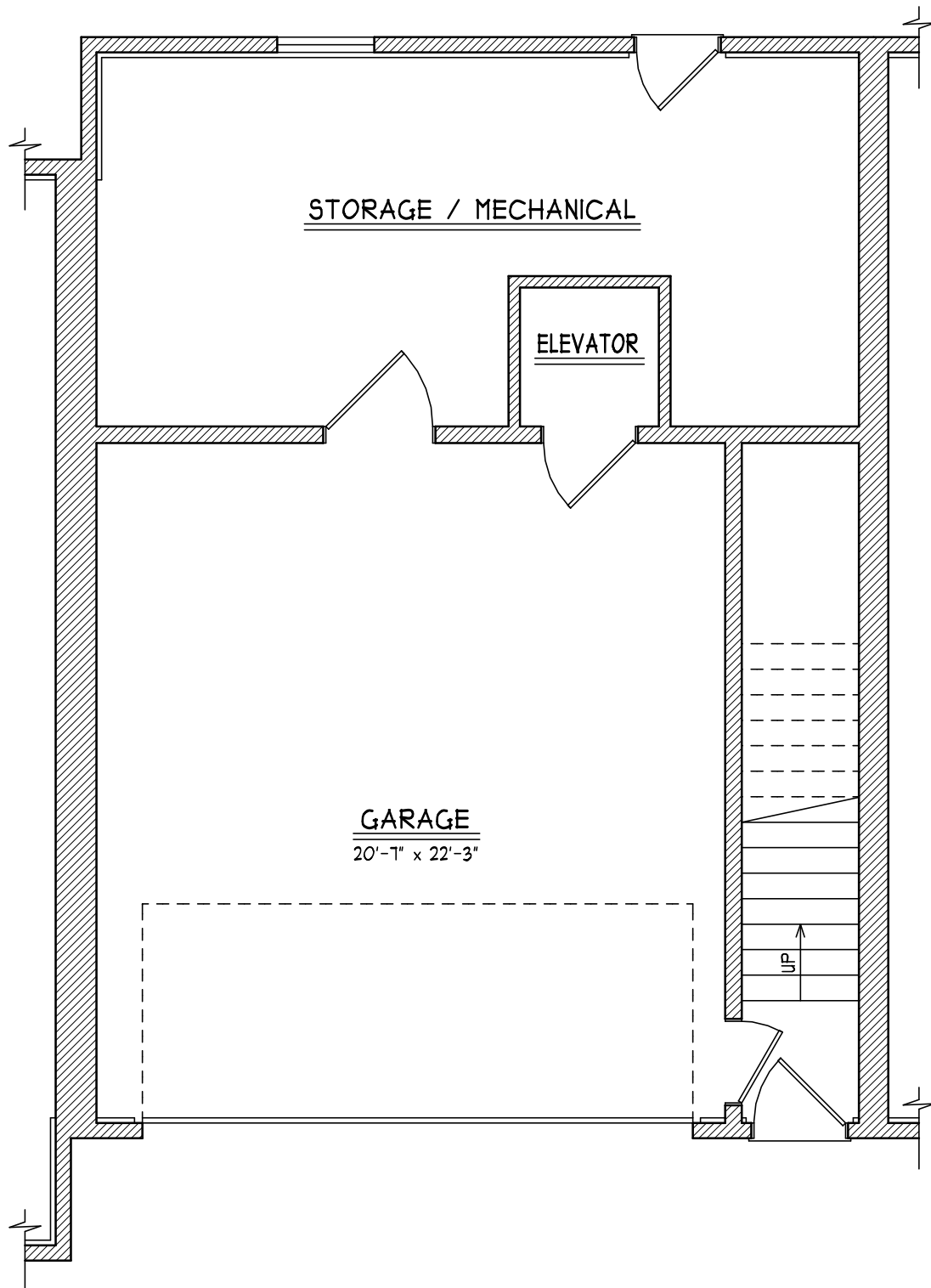


FRONT ELEVATION

(APPROX. 1,898 SQ. FT.)

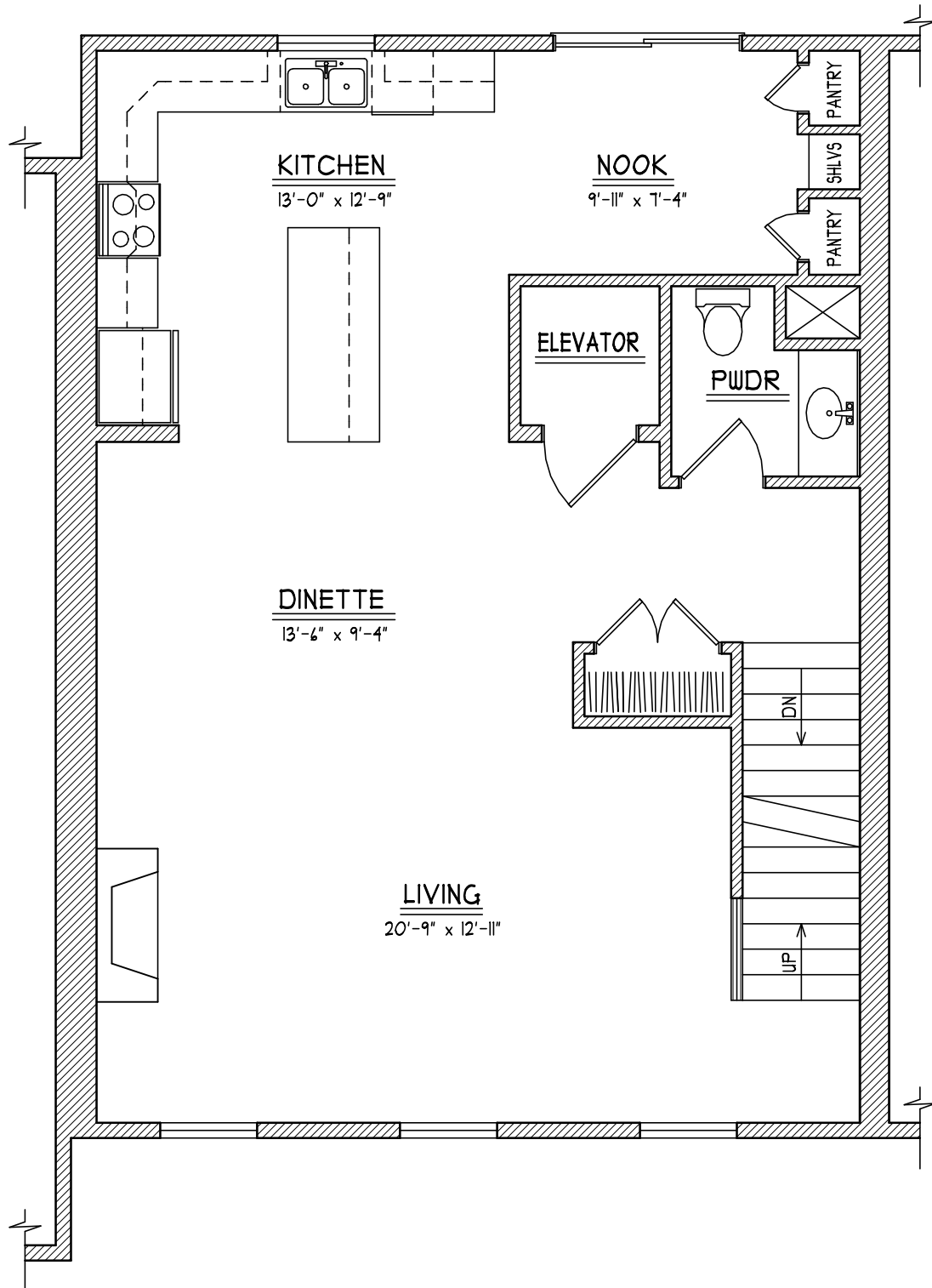

An in-line gear drive residential elevator delivers efficient performance for residential applications, with optimized controls and LED lighting helping keep energy consumption and operating costs low for the home owner.

Are Residential Elevators Costly to Maintain?

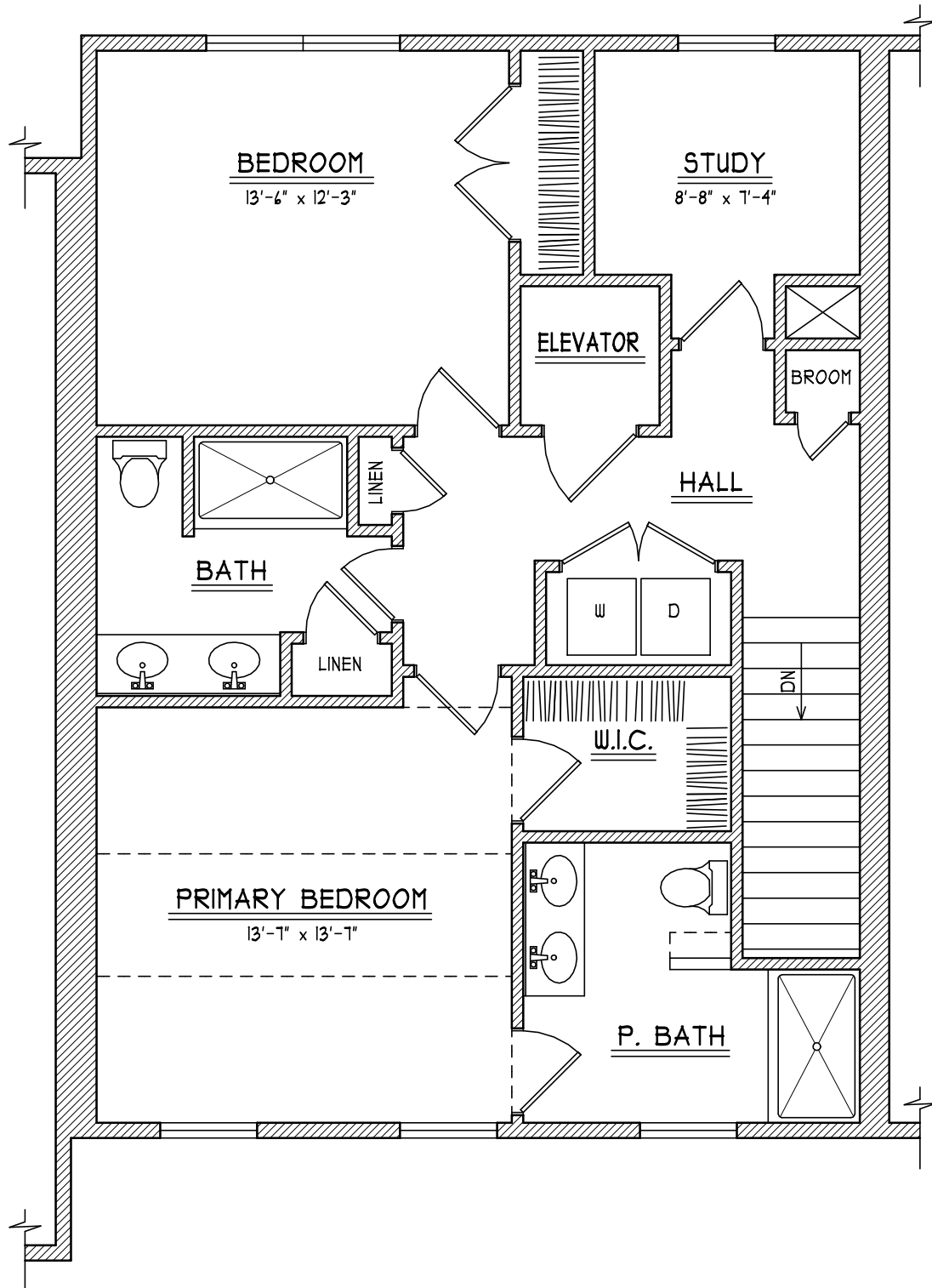
- Like other systems in your home regular maintenance will extend the life and performance of the system. Elevator maintenance contracts are reasonable averaging \$225 per year.

Can I Get Stuck in My Elevator?

- Your elevator will come with many advanced safety features to prevent this from happening including Battery lowering during power outages, in-car lighting, emergency stop switch and alarm, safety switches for gates and doors, battery backup emergency lighting and alarm, enhanced gate bypass monitor, unauthorized hoist way entry detection, and a slack chain safety device.
